Congratulations to Győző!

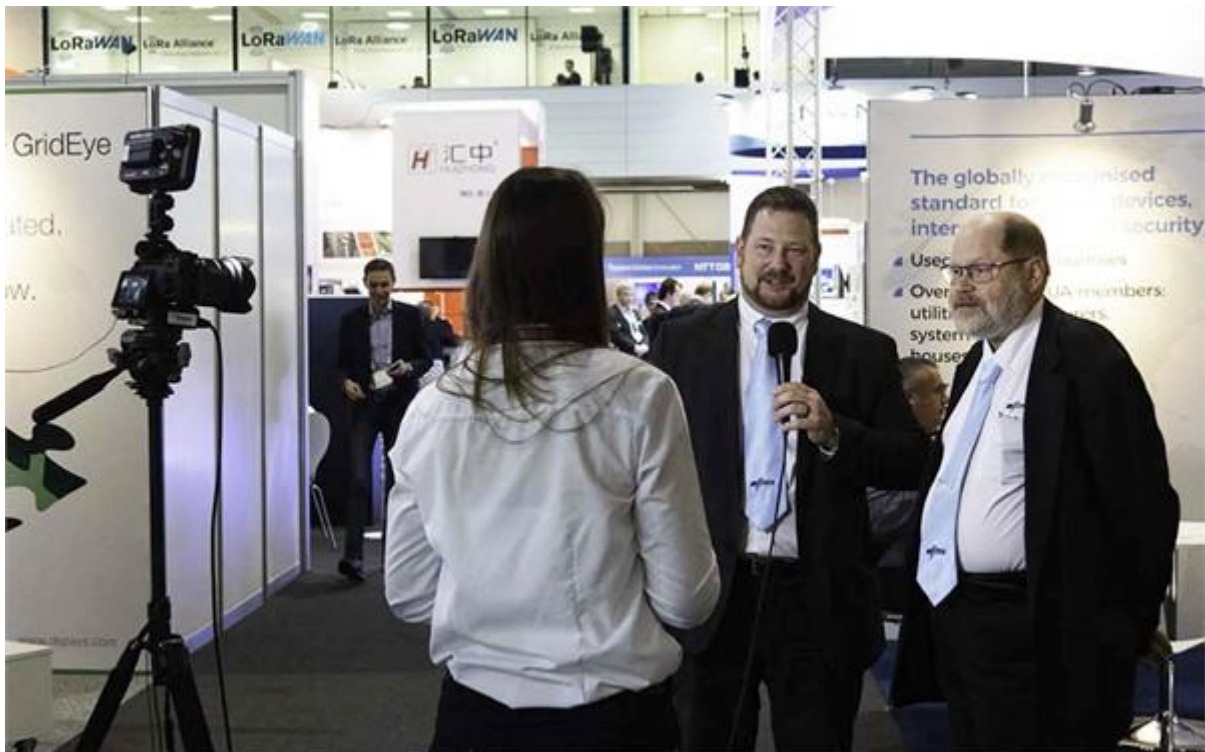
Our long-standing president, Mr Győző Kmethy, receives a gift.
